

988: A Direct Link for Suicide Prevention & Crisis Support

AUDIENCE:

All interested parties

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this communication is inform interested parties of the 988 lifeline.

Trained crisis response professionals can provide support to individuals considering suicide, self-harm, or any behavioral, mental health or substance abuse need. Lifeline services are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week at no cost to the caller.

DISCUSSION:

Pennsylvanians will soon have a new, easier way to connect to behavioral or mental health crisis services. Dialing 988 will connect callers directly to the <u>National Suicide</u> Prevention Lifeline.

Starting on July 16, 2022, people who call, text, or chat with 988 will be directly connected to the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline. The existing Lifeline phone number (1-800-273-8255) will remain available. Callers can also connect with the Veterans Crisis Line or receive assistance in Spanish. These services will be available 24 hours a day, seven days a week and are free to any caller no matter where they live.
