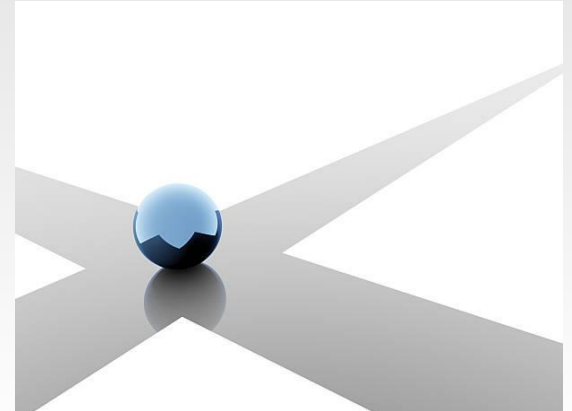

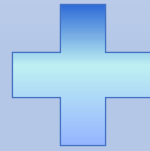

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System pressure

- Waiver Renewals (status – CMS approved extension)
  - Create a discreet service for Remote Supports
  - Increase participant access to supportive technology services
  - Increase quality by adding additional qualifications (RESNA cert and SHIFT - Enabling Technology Integration Specialist)
  - Clearer definition how the service works
  - Establish rules for privacy, redundancy, security, ISP planning, Provider Qualifications
  - Secure Appendix K flexibility for "Services provided using remote technology"

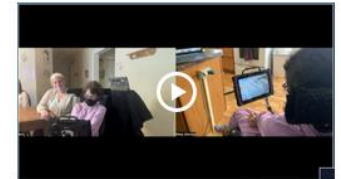

- **Provide Funding for Technology that Enhances HCBS Provision**
  - Date Issued: April 15, 2022
  - Applications close: October 31, 2022
  - Number of Providers that submitted proposals: 100
  - **Examples of Applications:**
    - Electronic Health Records
    - Electronic Documentation Software/Hardware
    - Electronic Medication Administration Records
    - IT Consulting
    - Workforce Engagement Management solutions
    - Risk Management Software

# Technology Task Force



The goal of the Technology Task Force initiative is to develop strategies to incorporate and expand the use of technology for individuals with disabilities.

Four workgroups have been created to support this initiative.

## Policy & Procedures, Service Definitions, and Measurement & Evaluation

**Objective:** Collaborate with ODP to support the development/revision of policies and procedures that identify gaps in current policy, break down perceived barriers to accessing technology, and support the expanded use of technology

**Goal:** Develop PA Technology Guide

## Expanding Technology in Supporting Living Service

**Objective:** Identify ways in which technology can be used to support individuals to acquire, maintain, or improve skills necessary to live independently

**Goal:** Conduct virtual roadshow to share stories and experiences

## Strategic Partnership and Funding

**Objective:** Create resources for stakeholders to better understand funding mechanisms as well as identify opportunities for technical assistance
