

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Spending Deadline Extended **ODP Announcement 22-107**

AUDIENCE:

All Intellectual Disability/Autism (ID/A) and Adult Autism Waiver (AAW) Service Providers, Supports Coordination Organizations (SCOs), Administrative Entities (AEs), and Other Interested Parties

PURPOSE:

On June 3, 2022, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) extended the ARPA spending deadline for states, adding an additional year through March 31, 2025.

Subsequently, the Office of Developmental Programs (ODP) is extending the timeframe for providers and SCOs to utilize the one-time supplemental funding initiatives through **October 31, 2024** for the two ARPA initiatives detailed in the announcement links below:
