

HCSIS Release 90.15 Announcement

HCSIS Release 90.15 goes live on April 1, 2023. This release incorporates seventeen (17) Maintenance Items, and WO3077 ODP EIM Target Identifier Format Updates. This release newsletter provides a review of these system changes.

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Maintenance Updates

OCDEL-BEISFS: Users can Submit a Second I/T to PS Transfer if Initial Request was Canceled or Referred Back

Description of Change

With Release 90.15, when an Infant/Toddler to Preschool transfer is initiated and then referred back (or cancelled), the Upcoming Transitions screen will no longer prevent the user from initiating a second transfer request. HCSIS will also no longer issue the error message "One of the Selected Cases is Already Initiated for Transfer" when the user is attempting to initiate the transfer a second time. The user is now able to submit a second I/T to a PS transfer, with the second transfer processing successfully.

Prior to Release 90.15, the user was unable to submit a second I/T to PS transfer through the "Upcoming Transitions" screen if the initial request was canceled or referred back. This issue occurred when a preschool user referred back the request, an I/T user canceled their own request, or when HCSIS performed an automatic refer-back after 15 days of the initial transfer.

Users will verify that an individual which is shared between ODP, and another program office does not appear on the report when the ODP case is closed. This will occur even when the case for the other program office remains open.

Prior to Release 90.15, the Demographics by County Report was pulling and displaying some closed ODP cases when the user requested the report with the Consumer Status of "Active" parameter. This occurred when an individual was shared between two program offices (ODP and another program office) and the ODP case was closed but the case for the other office was open.

With Release 90.15, users will now be prompted to update the mandatory Description field in the Physical Assessment screen and will no longer experience a HCSIS Common Error if the Description field is empty, but the System Area drop-down field is populated. The following message will now display: "Input(s) are mandatory".

Prior to Release 90.15, users were not prompted to enter a value in the mandatory Description field after clicking Save. Instead, if the Description field was left blank, but a value was entered for the System Area, the following HCSIS common error would result: "HCSIS Common Error: Nullable object must have a value."

Prior to the 90.15 Release, in cases where the Service Note Extract report returned zero Service Note records for a report request, the Service Notes Extract reports were showing the Request Status as "New" instead of "Processed" after the nightly batch jobs completed. With Release 90.15, when trying to add a new MBI while using an existing policy number, users will no longer be able to erroneously overwrite an existing MBI record after receiving the message "Consumer MBI already exists in the system. Duplicate record cannot be added."

Prior to Release 90.15, the existing MBI record was being updated instead of HCSIS throwing a validation message. Users would initially receive the message "Consumer MBI already exists in the system. Duplicate record cannot be added," when trying to add a new MBI record while using an existing policy number. But after clicking [Save] a second time, the message "Operation Successful" displayed and the record was updated, even though it should not have been.

This data copy happened anytime the user saved the Administrative Review Information page. If the user made changes to the subsequent pages and saved the Administrative Review Information page again, then the updated information was overwritten. This caused incorrect information to be submitted with the Administrative Review document.


